Proposed trip to the Welshpool & Llanfair Railway and the Severn Valley Railway on the weekend of the 30th/31st May 2020

Coach pick-ups on Sat 30th:

Weston Super Mare, Locking Road car park, 7.45am

Clevedon, TUI Travel shop, Kenn Road 8.15 am,

Portishead, near Iceland shop, High Street 8.45am

Itinerary

Proceeding from Portishead to the Welshpool & Llanfair light railway, with refreshment stop on route (possibly), arriving Llanfair approx 12.15 pm. There is a restaurant, loco sheds and a shop at the station. We pick up our steam train at 15.30 pm, the return train arriving at Llanfair at approx. 17.25pm. We then drive to Telford to stay at the Mercure Telford Madeley Hotel arriving at approx. 6.30 pm. The evening is at your own leisure, dinner is available at the hotel at your own expense, or you may go to nearby hostelrys.

After a buffet style breakfast (included in the price) at the Mercure Hotel, we proceed to the Severn Valley Railway, which should take approx. 20 mins. There will be time to explore Bridgnorth with its funicular railway then we will have a trip to Kidderminster with time to explore before the return trip to Bridgnorth.

We should arrive back at approx. 17.00 pm (Portishead) 17.30 pm (Clevedon) & 18.15 pm (Weston).

The cost of the weekend is provisionally set at £120 pp. (based on two sharing a double room or a twin room) while single rooms attract a supplement of £18 pp. The cost includes the coach fare, return journeys on the two railways, hotel accommodation and buffet breakfast.
